**Sub: Furnishing of the complete details of the goods being imported - Reg.**

Attention of all Importers, Custom House Agents, the Trading public and others is invited to the Public Notice No.41/2002 dated 18.02.2002 issued by this Custom House and the existing procedure of filing of import documents under the Indian Customs EDI System. It is seen that inspite of the above mentioned Public Notice the description of goods given in the Bill of Entry is still incomplete, and does not contain important and relevant details such as make, model, brand, specification, size, composition, quality, strength, units, Chemical/Botanical Name etc. These details are of crucial importance in exercising any meaningful valuation scrutiny, and comparison of the declared value of the goods.

In case the details are incomplete, the Bills of Entry may be returned with a query memo and would cause delay in assessment. In view of the above, it is henceforth made obligatory on the part of the importer to furnish the correct and complete details of the goods being imported, before the consignment is assessed to duty.
